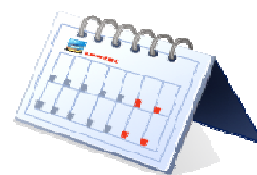

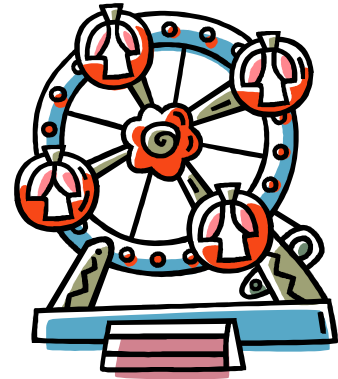


The Cookbooks have arrived!! They are in the School Office if you would like to purchase one, stop by. Cost is only \$10.00. It has some great recipes.

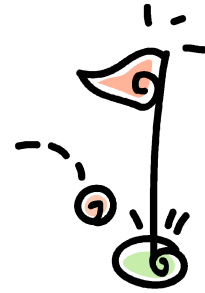

News from Stan Edmonds, Athletic Director:

If your child is a current student at Byne Christian School (6th - 12th grade) and would like to come to the school gym and start conditioning in anticipation for the upcoming basketball season, this info is for you.



Beginning Sept. 24 from 6 pm - 8 pm, the gym will be open to those Byne students and it will be similar to an "open gym" atmosphere where your child can run laps, shoot basketball, play a pickup basketball game, etc. until the official basketball tryouts begin, which is later in October. We will offer these conditioning sessions on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. This is not mandatory, but is being offered for your child's benefit to get ready for basketball tryouts. If the girls volleyball team has a late practice, we will need to be sensitive to that, but Coach Permison told me they are normally done before 6 pm.

A few ground rules and comments.....

1. I need a Byne School parent, teacher or coach to sit in the gym while the athletes (boys and girls) condition for these 2 hours or we will not be able to offer it. I know some of you have mentioned to me you could help in this area and we can use you. Email me with the days you can help and I will coordinate it with all of you.

2. The Volleyball nets will remain up during this conditioning time. It is still volleyball season and I do not want the nets to be moved. The bleachers will remain pulled out during the conditioning as well due to volleyball still in season. Please be careful around the volleyball nets.

3. If your child is currently participating in a fall sport (golf, volleyball or soccer) at Byne, they need to get their coach's permission prior to participating in this conditioning.

4. The Byne maintenance staff will turn off the lights and lock the gym upon the end of each conditioning session.
